Course in Applied Vocational Study Skills (CAVSS)
Underpinning Skills in Industry Qualifications (USIQ)

What is it?

CAVSS and USIQ offer in-class support for students. This support involves a literacy or numeracy lecturer team-teaching with the vocational lecturer to assist all students with the learning process.

The role of the CAVSS/USIQ lecturer is to identify and respond to students' needs by providing literacy and numeracy support to prepare them for assessment activities or to perform industry tasks.

What are the benefits?

Students enrolled in CAVSS/USIQ are provided with additional student/lecturer support in the classroom. Students can use the CAVSS/USIQ support to build on their skills and may be better prepared for the course requirements.

How is it organised?

CAVSS/USIQ support is organised by the vocational teaching team when additional literacy and numeracy support is required. The support is available to the whole class.

What are the costs?

None! CAVSS/USIQ units are free for all students.

Are there assessments?

No! There are no assessments associated with CAVSS and USIQ delivery. You will only be completing assessments/tasks for the vocational units that you have enrolled in.

You may see the CAVSS or USIQ units on your enrolment confirmation.

Just remember, they are free and there are no additional assessments!
