Dress requirements / PPE

- Protective eye wear
 - o Safety glasses must meet Australian Standards AS1337
 - o Safety glasses must be worn in workshops/ potting sheds/ glass houses etc
 - Tinted or clear safety glasses must be worn for all practical activities including; planting, pruning, operating machinery, nursery activities, irrigation and chemical applications.
- Safety steel-capped work boots must be worn at all times
 - Steel capped safety boots must be worn for all practical activities, workshops, potting sheds and nursery
 - Enclosed footwear must be worn
 - o No thongs, sandals or any open footwear permitted
- Hearing protection
 - Hearing protection is required as a minimum requirement, as per safe operating procedures for using machinery and equipment. Apprentices and Trainees must provide their own.
- Hand protection
 - Hand protection is required. This is a requirement when carrying out practical activities. Apprentices and Trainees must provide their own work gloves.
- Sun protection
 - Long sleeves and long pants
 - o Wide brimmed hat for outside activities
 - SPF 30+ or 50+ sunscreen
 - o Apprentices and Trainees must provide their own
