Open cabling and structured cabling competencies

On completion of the two units of competency, you will need to register as a cabling provider. To do this you will need to follow the steps listed below:

- Log on to Student Portal and download a copy of your statement of results (same login details as the Student network on campus)
- Choose a cabling registrar to register with (BRCA, TITAB, ACRS, ASIAL, FPA Aust.)
 - http://www.acma.gov.au/Industry/Telco/Infrastructure/Cablingrules/cablingregistrars
- Fill out their online registration form, making sure you apply for:
 - Open Cabling Registration
 - Structured Cabling Competency
 - Coaxial Competency
- You will need to provide a signed statutory declaration stating that you have over 360 hours of cabling experience.
- Pay the registration fee.
