Study support

Study Support is a free service to help you develop your skills and prepare for your assignments. You will be matched with a Study Support Assistant who will assist with goal setting and study skills, reading, writing, numeracy, time management and assessment planning.

Koora Marr (Thornlie Campus) and Kadadjiny Mia (Rockingham Campus) are safe and socially inclusive spaces where Students can feel spiritually, culturally and emotionally protected. The Centres have internet, kitchen and tea and coffee facilities, student study and chill-zones, tables and chairs for group or individual work activities and are open daily from 7.30am to 4.00pm.
