



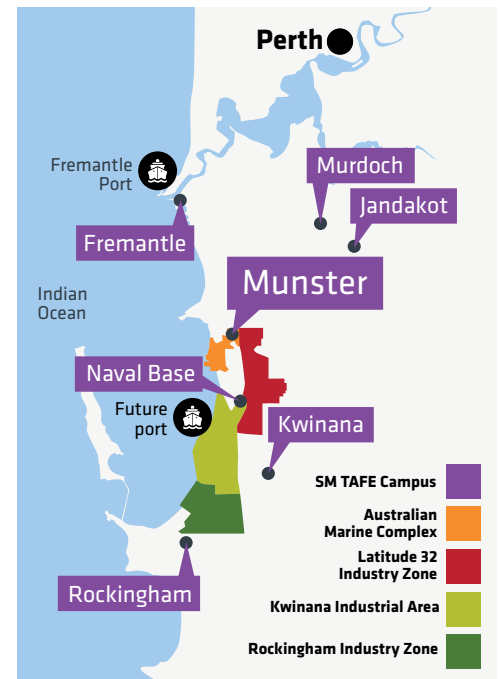
Global Advanced Industry Hub Munster Campus in the Hub (2022–2032)
