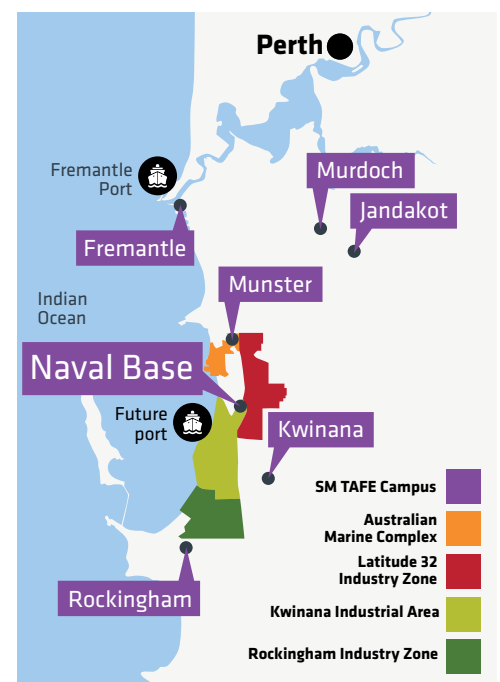
Naval Base Campus in the Hub (2022–2032)
