- Develop technical skills and an understanding of technology and automation in the defence industry
- Assist students with a pathway to employment or higher-level qualifications
- Provide a pathway to a career in engineering drafting, or as an engineering associate.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must be female (or identify as female), Australian residents and competent in communication and mathematics. These skills are equivalent to completion of Year 10, but may also be achieved through previous work or informal learning experiences. The scholarship has been designed to meet the needs of women who are returning to work, are seeking a career change, have recently completed high school, or need an alternative pathway to university. The learning environment is structured to provide a high level of support for students returning to formal education.


